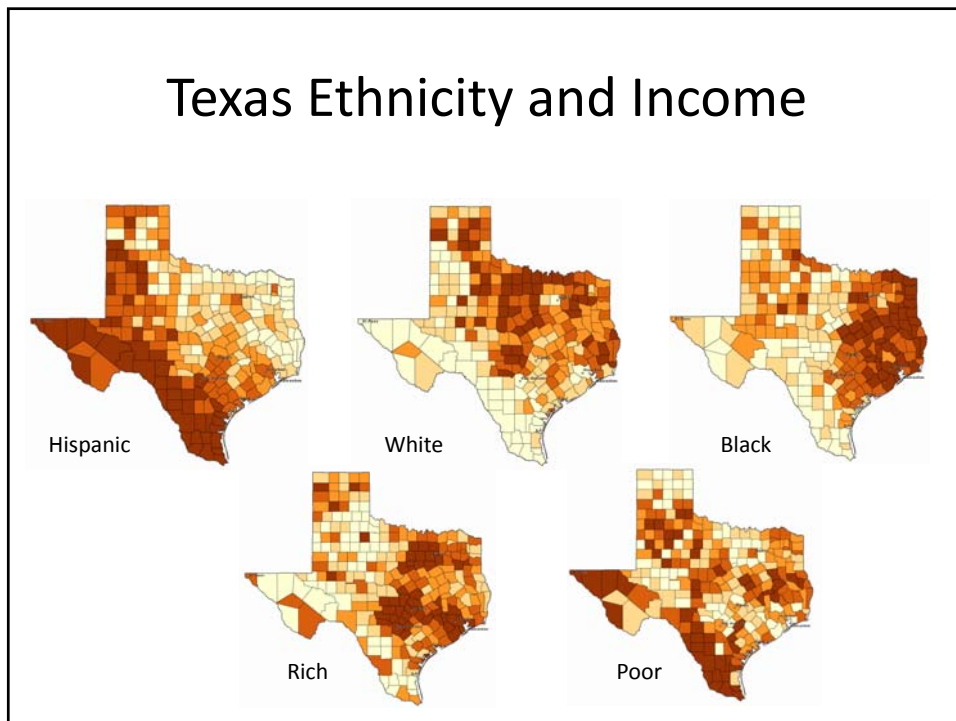

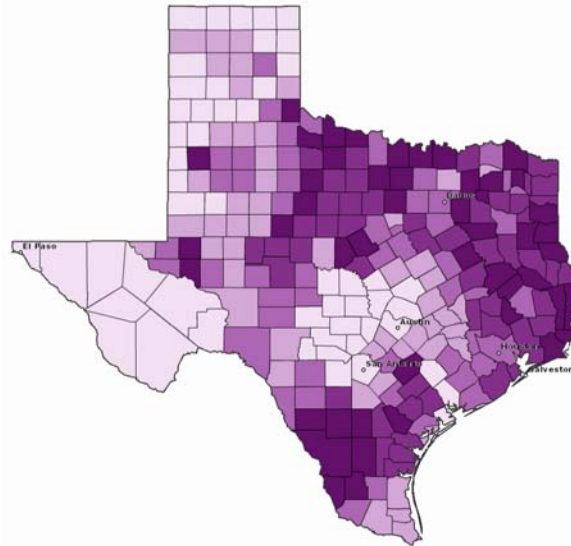


Rate of Ischemic Stroke Mortality



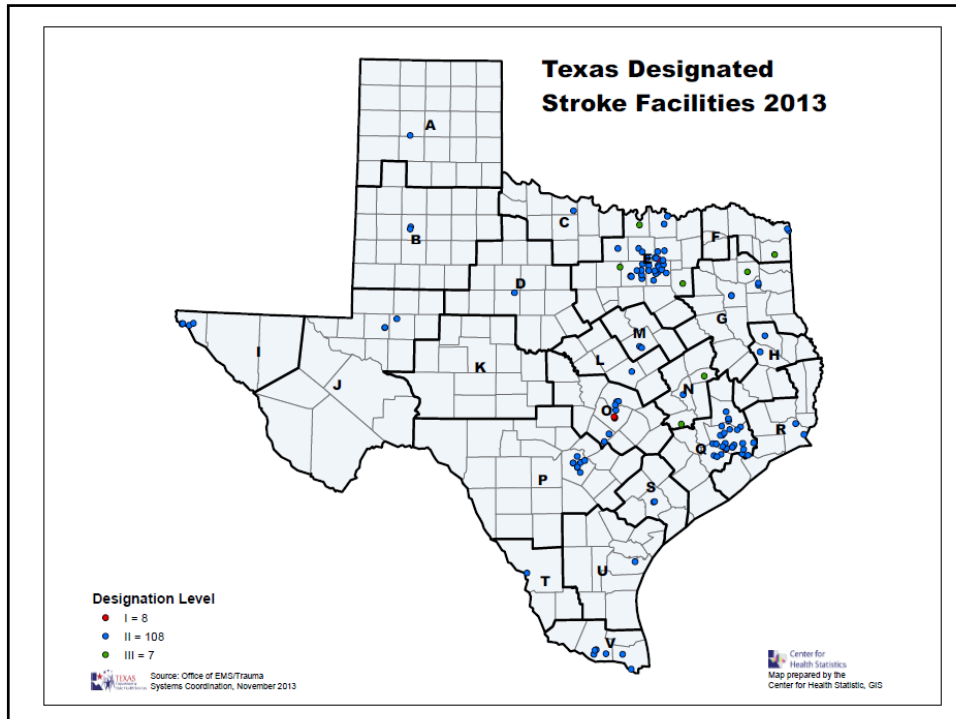


Texas Stroke Hospitalization Rate



Texas Stroke Care

- Health and Safety Code: §773.201 Emergency Stroke Services (2005)
 - 79th Legislature, Senate Bill 330, 2005
 - Stroke System of Care, modeled after trauma
- Texas Administrative Code 157.133 State Stroke Facility Designation & Transport (2009)
 - Comprehensive (Level I), JC, DNV certified
 - Primary (Level II), JC, DNV, HFAP certified
 - Support (Level III), TETAF certified



83rd Legislature SB1 Rider 97 (2012)

- Out of funds appropriated above in Strategy A.3.1, Chronic Disease Prevention, the Department of State Health Services may expend \$2,500,000 in General Revenue Funds in fiscal year 2014 and \$2,500,000 in General Revenue Funds in fiscal year 2015 for the purpose of funding the Texas Council on Cardiovascular Disease and Stroke.
- The Texas Council on Cardiovascular Disease and Stroke shall allocate \$4,500,000 of those funds over the biennium to the Stroke System of Care coordination (Lone Star Stroke) and \$500,000 of these funds over the biennium to the Stroke/STEMI (ST-Segment Elevation Myocardial Infarction) Data Collection.
